

SUBMITTING A MANUSCRIPT FOR PUBLICATION: A TRUE PARTNERSHIP

IPOC Press seeks to publish original and high-quality works – in Italian or English – that permit readers to acquire critical thinking, to reflect, to confront new ideas, to measure themselves against important questions, to broaden their perspectives, and to make the world a better place. As you may already have read on our website, our preference is for books that are intercultural and interdisciplinary. Because our area of focus is the humanities, it could hardly be otherwise.

Perhaps there aren't many of us left, perhaps there are lots of us (which would be wonderful). Our mission, in any case, is to be the kind of publisher that takes risks in its choices and which is concerned first about a book's content and second about an author's "name." In brief, **IPOC requires no payment whatsoever for the printing of the books we publish.** If what you've written is of interest to us, we will offer you a contract that provides for an immediate advance against royalties of €50.00 (fifty Euros) and sets out a royalty schedule (a percentage of the cover price) to be paid on the basis of the actual number of copies sold. The contract also guarantees that you or anyone authorized to act on your behalf will always have the ability to verify our sales figures. None of this is exceptional – except perhaps for our desire to establish a relationship with our authors that is serious, correct, and straightforward: a true partnership. Only under such circumstances can trust and complete collaboration exist between author and publisher – conditions we believe are fundamental for all parties to benefit fully.

WHY PUBLISH WITH IPOC?

IPOC Press was founded with a double objective in mind: to publish books in both Italian and English and to print our titles through the exclusive use of the print-on-demand system.

If you should decide to submit a manuscript to us, you should know that is our desire to make our books available in at least two languages: English and Italian. Obviously, many factors come into play with regard to the preparation of translations, but if all parties are in agreement there is a great likelihood that your work will be translated into English (if it is written in Italian) or into Italian (if it is written in English).

If you should decide to submit a manuscript to us, you should know that IPOC Press's books are not distributed via the traditional wholesaler/bookstore model. We sell directly to all bookstores, furnishing them with a standard discount, and we also sell to the public online via the best-known sales outlets for books. One recent report estimates that 21 million individuals use the internet in Italy.

If you should decide to submit a manuscript to us, you should know that, thanks to print-on-demand technology, your book will enjoy significant advantages:

- ★ the assurance that your book will never go out of print;
- ★ the possibility to reach markets in the United States and Great Britain through wholesalers and distributors in those two countries;
- ★ the assurance that your book will be available worldwide via amazon.com, amazon.fr, amazon.co.uk, Barnes and Noble, and Powell's, etc., as well as through IPOC Press's own online bookshop.

HOW TO PROCEED

If you should decide to submit a manuscript to us, then, please carefully follow the procedure outlined below:

1. Send us, via email, an abstract of your manuscript, no more than three pages in length. The abstract makes it possible for us to provide you with a quick evaluation of the subject matter. Our email address is: ipoc@ipocpress.com.
2. If we are interested in reading the entire manuscript, we will send you an email inviting you to send it to us. At that point, we will also ask you to forward payment to IPOC in the sum of €20.00 (twenty Euros) which covers the cost of manuscript review. Payment methods include:

3. Send us one copy of your manuscript, double-spaced and printed in blank ink on either A4 or "letter-sized" paper in no smaller than 12-point type. If you have made payment via BancoPosta/Postal Account Transfer, include a copy of the payment receipt (the "Attestazione di Versamento") along with your manuscript.

4. Within 30 days of receipt of your manuscript or of verification of your payment, whichever comes last, we will contact you by email. In fact, you can always count on us to give you a prompt response, regardless of whether or not we consider your manuscript to be appropriate for IPOC.
5. If, as we hope, your manuscript is judged to be suitable for publication by IPOC, we will send you a copy of our standard contract, which we will ask you to sign and return to us.

Do not hesitate to contact us if you have any questions or require additional information regarding our editorial procedures and publication processes.

A straightforward approach, clarity, honesty: For IPOC, each published book is the beginning of a true partnership between author and publisher, for the benefit of both.
